Comprehensive Wound Assessment (4.5 HR)

Wound Hygiene (1.5 HR)

Discussion of the further evolution of the Wound Hygiene concept focusing on how and when to implement for all tissue types of hard-to-heal wounds and applying the 4 Steps of Wound Hygiene. Examining the addition of unhealthy granulation tissue as a key indicator in the healing trajectory, and how recognition can influence effective healing results. Explanation of an implementation guide for proactive wound healing practices powered by Wound Hygiene.
